

Rules and Regulations

1. Introduction

The 7th VGIK International Summer School **July 06 – 26, 2015** in the City of Kirov, Russian Federation is organized by:

- Russian State University of Cinematography n. a. S. Gerasimov (VGIK), under the patronage of:
- The Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation,
- The Department of Culture of Kirov Region.

The aim of the school is:

- to gain extra knowledge and acquire practical training in the field of cinematography
- to establish academic and creative connections among the students of film schools from all over the world
- to exchange knowledge and experience in the field of film education

2. The academic and film production activities

Within the framework of the VGIK International Summer School the students of **Film Direction, Cinematography, Animation & Multimedia, or Computer Graphics** departments of film schools from all over the globe will get together in Kirov:

- to attend master-classes of European and Russian filmmakers
- to present and discuss their reflections on the subject, corresponding with the summer school slogan
- to explore the area of shooting
- to get expertise and professional tips of the masters at all stages of film production
- to shoot a 10-minute documentary film, corresponding with the summer school slogan **The Vyatka Region. Tradition and Modernity.**
- to shoot a 3-minute animation film, corresponding with the summer school slogan **The Vyatka Region. Tradition and Modernity.**

3. The **working language** of the VGIK International Summer School – **English**

4. The dates of the VGIK International Summer School activities are from **July 06 – 26, 2015**. Please, note that the **animation section** takes place from **July 16 – 26, 2015**.

5. To participate, please, submit by May 10, 2015 the following documents:

- completed application form
- one photograph
- letter of recommendation from a school or master
- trailer of an animation film, shot in the course of your studies at a film school, academy, or university (subtitled in English), or a link to the video
- synopsis or your reflections on the subject corresponding with the summer school slogan, that will underlie your documentary and animation films to be shot at the VGIK International Summer School

6. The terms of staying:

a) VGIK provides and covers:

- board and lodging for the participants
- equipment and materials for film production (mini DV-format)
- transportation costs within the Russian Federation
- a DVD with the collection of films made by the summer school participants

b) The participants pay for:

- round-trip air tickets
- obtaining Russian visa
- international health insurance
